Primary

Class 4b: Novice 2.1 – 80cms SJ Height

Secondary

Class 5b: Preliminary 1.1 – 65cms SJ Height

Class 6b: Preliminary 1.2 – 80cms SJ Height

Class 7b: Novice 2.1 – 95cms SJ Height

Class 8b: Novice 2.2 – 105cms SJ Height

If competing Dressage & CT only corresponding classes can be entered (i.e Class 1a & Class 1b), therefore only riding two dressage tests, where one test will count for both your Dressage and CT scores.

RULES AND CONDITIONS

- This event will be run in accordance with current EA rules
- All dressage tests are ridden in a 60m x 20m arena
- Primary classes are open to all students currently enrolled in a primary school (prep to year 6)
- Secondary classes are open to all students currently enrolled in a secondary school (year 7 to year 12)
- All riders must be accompanied by an adult
- No riders other than those competing are allowed to ride at the grounds
- One rider per horse rule applies
- Each combination may only compete in one combined training section and one dressage section
- Riders may ride more than one horse
- All riders must wear approved helmets and boots at all times whilst mounted
- Full school equestrian uniform must be worn
- Schools are responsible for gear check
- Riders to provide own bridle / saddle numbers
- Neither the organizing committee of the competition nor the school or owners of the property accept any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
- Strictly no dogs allowed
- Limited yards available at no cost
- No camping

Refund Policy
