General Rules and Conditions

- EA Rules apply. These can be found at www.equestrian.org.au or www.vic.equestrian.org.au
- This completion is open to all currently enrolled primary and secondary school students. A current EA number, PCAV number or letter from your school stating you are covered under their insurance, is required for insurance purposes.
- NO STALLIONS OR RIGS are permitted at any VEIS Interschool Competition.
- Schools must notify a suitably qualified Team Manager. Team Managers are responsible for gear checks; inappropriate gear will result in elimination.
- All riders must be currently enrolled at the school they are representing and must be accompanied by an adult.
- All riders must wear currently approved EA helmets (EA Helmet Rules, updated 19 October 2016) and riding boots whilst mounted. School equestrian uniform including white, beige, fawn or banana jodhpurs must be worn in all competition and for presentations. Jackets are permitted for Medium & Advanced Dressage. Gloves must be worn.
- **Schools are responsible for own gear check.** Spot checks may occur on the day.
- **Whips are permitted up to 100cm for ponies and 120cm for horses.**
- No riders other than those competing are allowed to ride on the grounds.
- One horse, one rider rule applies. Riders may ride more than one horse.
- Tests may be called.
- All dressage tests are ridden in a 60m x 20m arena.
- Combinations may enter a maximum of three tests. Two at the same level and one at a consecutive level (eg 2 preliminary tests and 1 novice test).
- Primary classes are open to all students currently enrolled in a primary school (Prep to Year 6).
- Secondary classes are open to all students currently enrolled in secondary school:
 - Intermediate classes are for students in year 7, 8 and 9
 - Senior classes are for students in year 10, 11 and 12
- Elementary, Medium and Advanced Dressage classes are open to primary and secondary students.
- Primary Preparatory is designed for beginner riders just learning to canter consistently. If a rider is cantering confidently, it is recommended they enter Preliminary Primary.
- Entry only accepted with full payment.
- Entries after the closing date will pay an additional \$10 per entry which will be paid at the time of entering. Later entries will be assigned early times, if accepted. In the event of excessive entries, they will be considered in order of receipt.
- Classes may run later or earlier than advertised. Riders are expected to be aware of changes to times and report accordingly. Riders who do not report in time to ride in their draw order may be eliminated.
- A \$10 administration fee will be deducted from all SCRATCHINGS. After closing date, as per EA Rules, a vet/doctor certificate will also be required for return of entry money less \$10 administration fee.
- Horses must be entered in their correct EA Dressage Grade. Any rider deemed to be riding in an incorrect grade will be eliminated.
- All appeals must be lodged by the Team Manager on the official form available from the organising committee, no later than 30 minutes after the incident, accompanied by \$50 which will only be refunded if the protest is upheld. All appeals will be considered by the Jury of Appeal on the day.
- All riders must provide own numbers as per draw and these must be worn on both sides of the bridle or saddle cloth.
- RGAPS reserves the right to alter or delete any event, and refuse entry with or without a reason.
- All riders must present at the Secretary's Office before they compete on the day.
- **No dogs allowed.**
